

# PRAYING THE TABERNACLE PRAYER MODEL

In the Old Testament, the Tabernacle was the dwelling place of God. It was built to His specifications exactly. God would meet with His people there. The Tabernacle had seven distinct stations that you went through. These stations can be used as a prayer model to show us steps we can take to connect with Him

## THE OUTER COURT

- Psalms 100:4 We enter His gates with thanksgiving
- Here we pray thanksgiving prayers for all that God has given us and for the people in our lives

## THE BRAZEN ALTAR

- The altar was where the animals were sacrificed. Here we thank God for the gift of Jesus and His sacrifice on the cross
- Pray for all that the cross provides: Salvation / Healing / Redemption / Blessing

## THE LAVER

- The laver was a large washing bowl that was used for ceremonial washing
- Pray for God to forgive our sins and wash us completely clean
- Pray through all the areas of your heart that need the cleansing of the Holy Spirit

## THE CANDLESTICK

- Then you saw the 7 branched candlestick. This represents the church and its people. We are the ones that the Holy Spirit burns in and through
- Pray for God to baptize you in the Holy Spirit. Pray to be a light in this world

## THE TABLE OF SHEWBREAD

- Then there was a table of ceremonial bread. This bread represents the Bible.
- Pray for a new hunger for the Word of God
- Pray and study the Bible at this time

## THE ALTAR OF INCENSE

- As you entered into the holy of holies, there was an altar of fragrant incense burning. This represents our worship going up to Him
- Worship God at this time. Telling God how much He means to you

## THE ARK OF THE COVENANT

- The final place in the tabernacle. The Ark is where God had His throne
- Pray for the people around your life. All those that are hurting and in need
